- Entry forms must be submitted and artwork received by the Art Department no later than end of school, Friday 27 June 2025. Term 2 Week 9
- Artwork can be of any medium IE acrylic, oil, watercolour, ink, pencil, pastel, charcoal, photography, digital imaging, multi-media
- Artwork must be no larger than 1.5m x 1.5m including frame
- If works are framed they must include a wire or hook to hang them from
- You can offer your artwork for sale, but any work sold must remain on display until the exhibition closes
- The winning entry will be chosen according to the following criteria
  - Creativity and originality
  - Sensitivity and skill in use of media
  - Presentation
- The judging panel consists of; Principal - Ms Meg Fay, Business Leader - Ms Vicki Cook, Art teacher and Artist - Ms Catherine Bourn
- The judges decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
